

Filipino Migrants in Japan Insight



In 1970, there was a registered Filipino population of 932 in Japan. The population increased slightly to 5,547 in 1980.

The Initial Filipino Migrants in Japan.

In the early 1980s, Filipino woman began to come to Japan to work at the nightclubs (Philippine pub) and the cabarets as hostesses.

From the early 1980s, many Japayuki San (Miss Japan-going) came from the Philippines to Japan on entertainer visas, ostensibly to work as dancers and singers. The Philippine pub boom reached its peak in 2004, when there were over 80,000 Filipino women in Japan on entertainer visas.

Japan landed on a human trafficking watch list and started cracking down heavily on these visas.

The number of Filipino technical intern trainees has reached 23,186, which was 8.38% of the population of Filipinos in Japan as of 2021.

A new visa status "Specific Skill", which allows foreigners to work in Japan, was newly created after the Immigration Control Act was revised in April 2019.

There were 276,615 Filipinos registered in Japan as of December 2021


