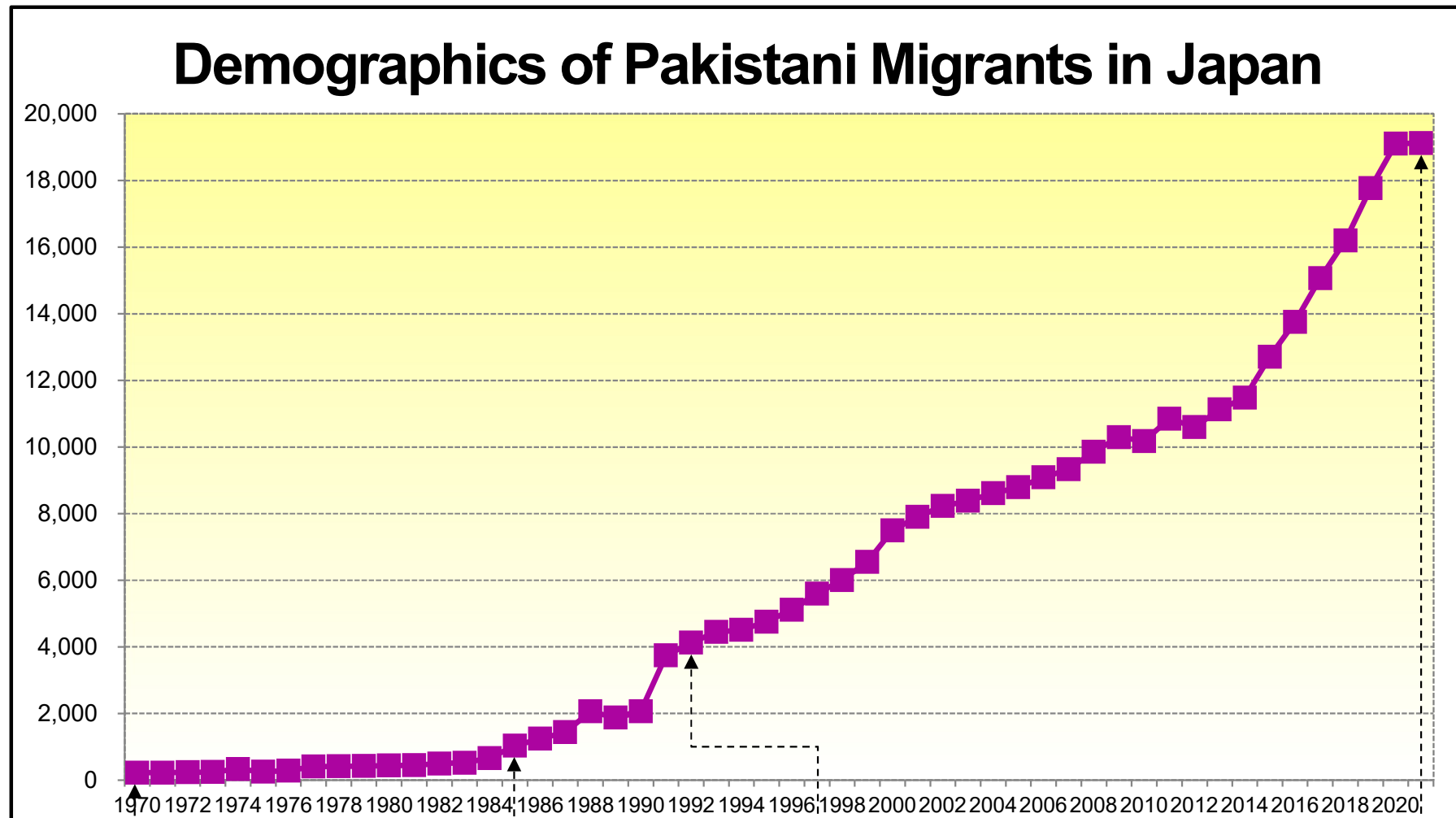

Pakistani Migrants in Japan Insight



By the end of 1970, there were 220 Pakistani nationals living in Japan. Its population has not increased until the middle of 1980s.

Many Pakistanis in Japan run used car export businesses. This trend was believed to have begun in the late 1970s, when a Pakistani trainee working in Japan sent 4 cars back to his homeland.

Pakistani migration to Japan started to grow to a large scale since the middle of 1980s as physical laborers.

Post-war economic growth has generated a strong demand for labor in the service industry, construction and manufacturing fields since the 1980s.

The number of Pakistanis illegally residing in Japan peaked in 1992 at 8,056 individuals and declined after that year.

Pakistani sources suggest that as late as 1999, the total population of Pakistanis was approximately 25,000 and still included a significant amount of illegal immigrants.

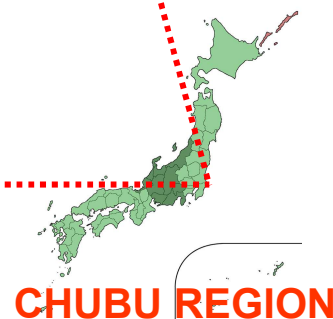
By December 31st, 2021, there were 19,120 residents. The majority of the Pakistani migrants live in the Kanto Region and Tokai Region.

15.17% of registered Pakistanis lived in Saitama, 10.12% in Aichi, 10.05% in Ibaraki, 10.05% in Chiba, 7.30% in Kanagawa, 6.87% in Tochigi, and the remaining 42.35% in other prefectures.

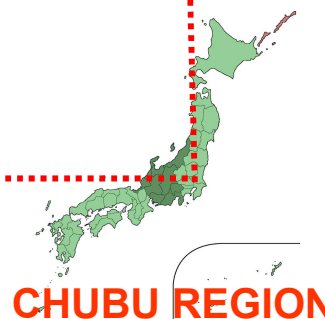

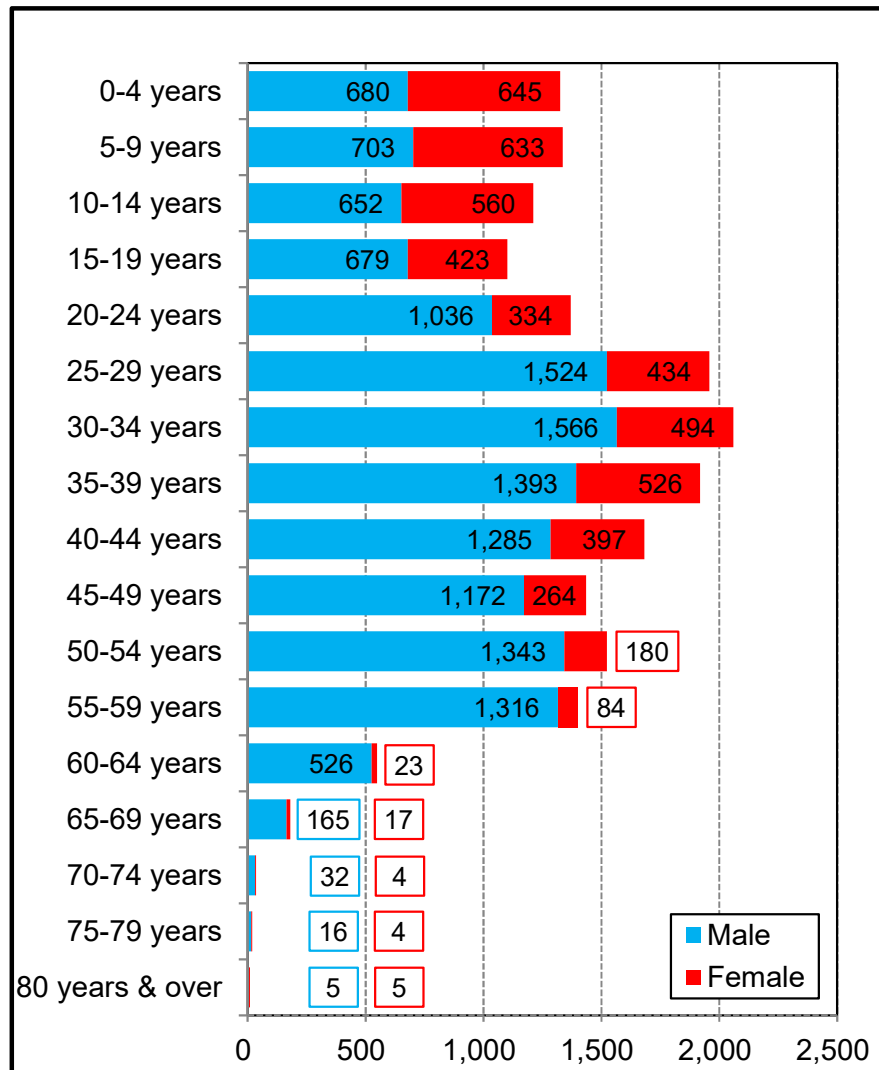
