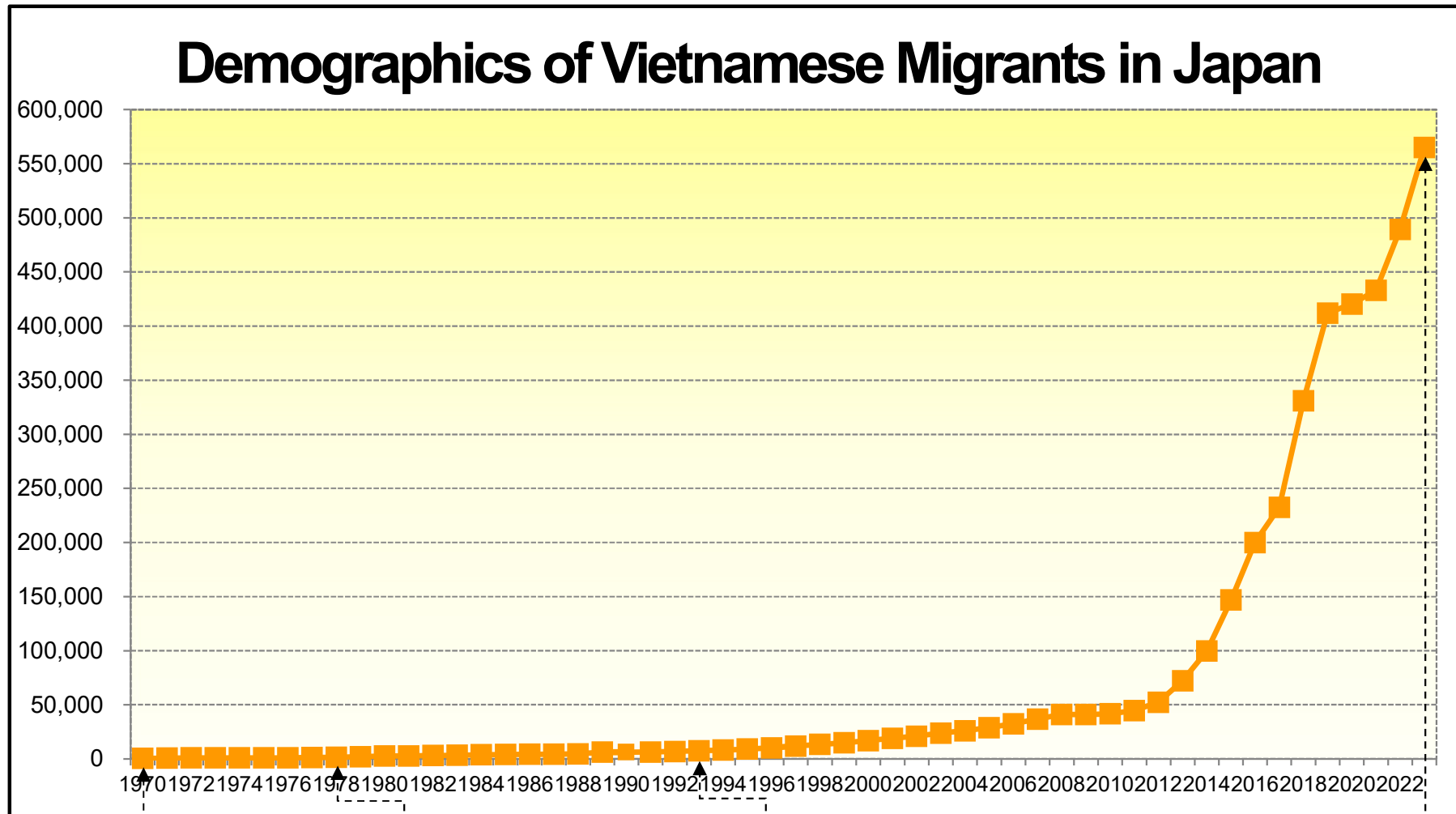

Vietnamese Migrants in Japan Insight



In 1970, there was a registered Vietnamese population of 557 in Japan. After 2 years, its population roughly doubled to 1,015.

The initial Vietnamese Migrants in Japan.

After the War, refugees from Vietnam increased and many boat people from South Vietnam arrived Japan in late 1970s.

It was the first time that Japanese Government began accepting a significant number of refugees either to allow them to resettle in Japan.

Under the Technical Intern Training Program introduced in 1993, the number of Vietnamese migrants has increased slightly.

The Technical Intern Training Program started in 1993 to provide employment opportunities for foreign nationals in Japan.

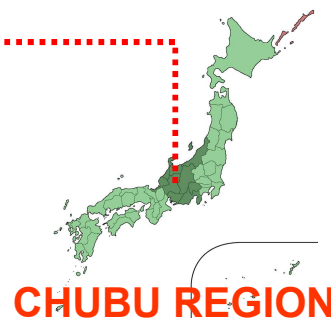
The number of Vietnamese technical intern trainees has reached 203,184, which was 36.00% of the population of Vietnamese in Japan as of 2023.

Vietnamese migrants in Japan has formed the third-largest community of foreign residents ahead of Filipinos in Japan.

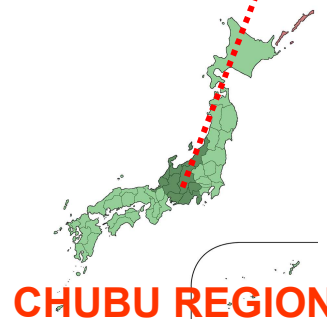

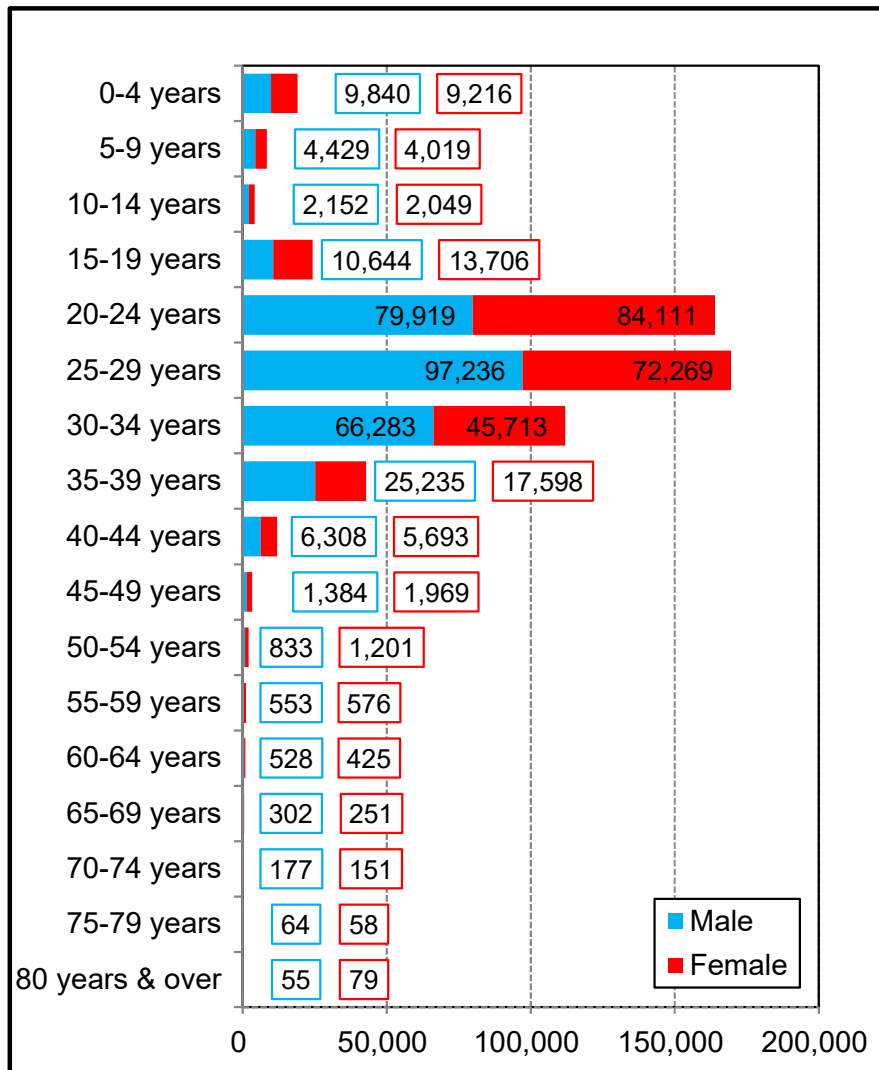

Median Age: Male 26.7 years old, Female 25.9 years old



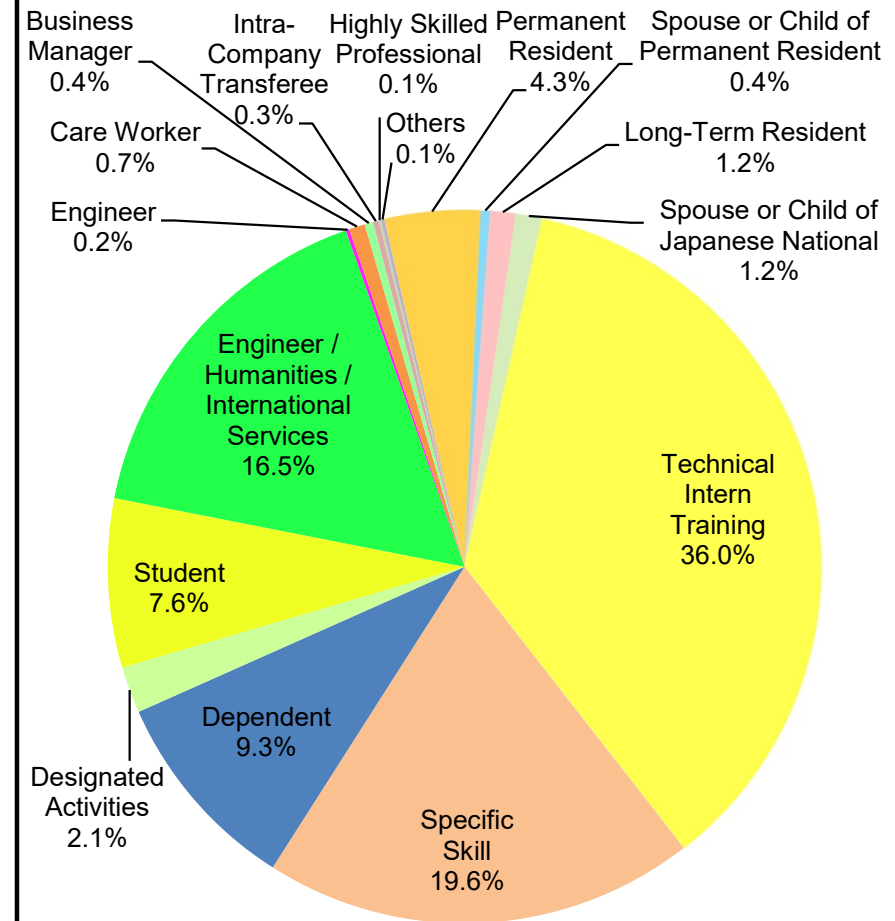
Visa Status of Vietnamese in Japan as of December 31st, 2023
