

Cambodian Migrants in Japan Insight



Following the Vietnamese army's invasion of Cambodia in 1978, several thousand Cambodians fled their country

The Government of Japan decided to accept Indo-Chinese refugees for settlement in Japan in 1978.

Under the Technical Intern Training Program introduced in 1993, the number of Cambodian migrants has increased slightly.

The Technical Intern Training

purpose of transferring skills,
technologies, or knowledge
accumulated in Japan.

The Cambodian Students
Association in Japan was
established in 1994 to provide
comprehensive support to
students from Cambodia

Between the late 1990s and the late 2000s the number of foreign students studying in Japan doubled. In 2021, the number of technical intern trainees has reached 7,475, which was 50.7% of the population of Cambodians in Japan.

Indian migrants in Japan has formed the 19th-largest community of foreign residents in Japan as of December 2021.


