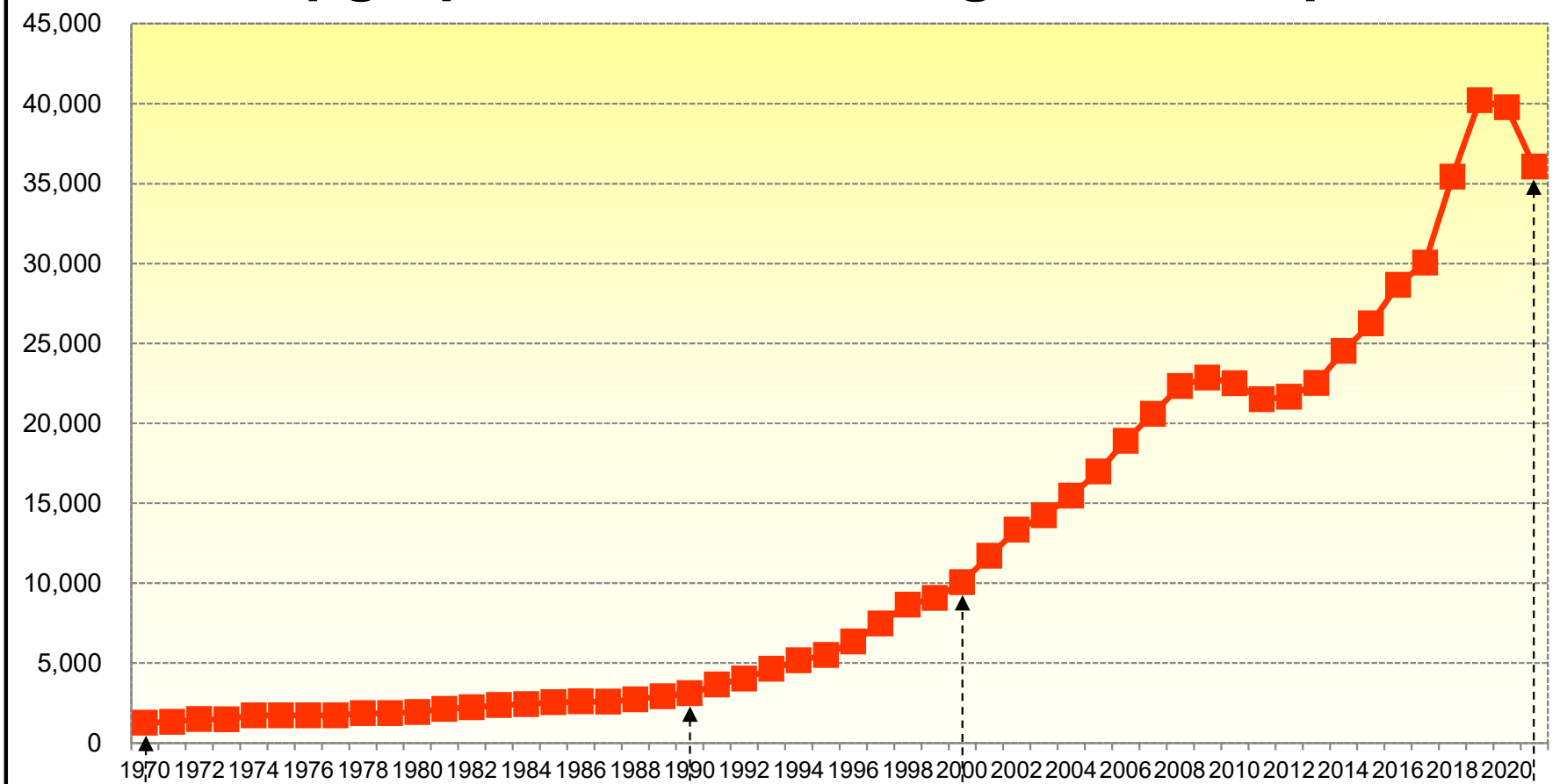

## Dempgraphics of Indian Migrants in Japan



In 1970, there were 1,266 Indians in Japan. Prior to the middle of 1980s, the Indian community in Japan has concentrated in Kobe.

After the opening of Japan, the Indian traders started to reside in the port town of Kobe in Hyogo Prefecture and Yokohama in Kanagawa Prefecture.

In 1990 Tokyo took the No. One position of Indian community in Japan, attracting IT engineers and intra-company transferees.

From the middle of the 1980s there was a sudden increase in the Indian population in Tokyo.

Many Japanese companies have invited many Indian IT professionals and engineers and started to live in Nishikasai area in Tokyo.

Indian Community of Edogawa was established in 2000 to help the Indian residents by exchanging the information on daily life in Japan.

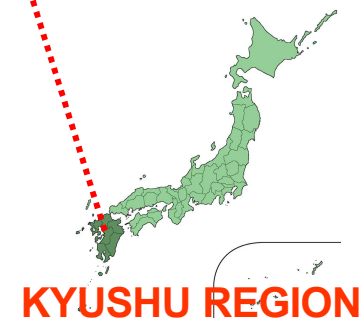
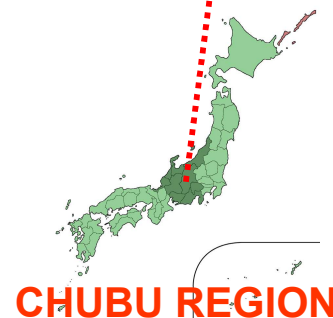
The number of Indian skilled labors and engineers has reached 13,016, which is 36.1% of the population of Indian residents in Japan.

Indian migrants in Japan has formed the 13<sup>th</sup>-largest community of foreign residents in Japan as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

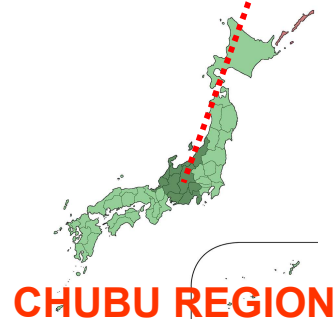

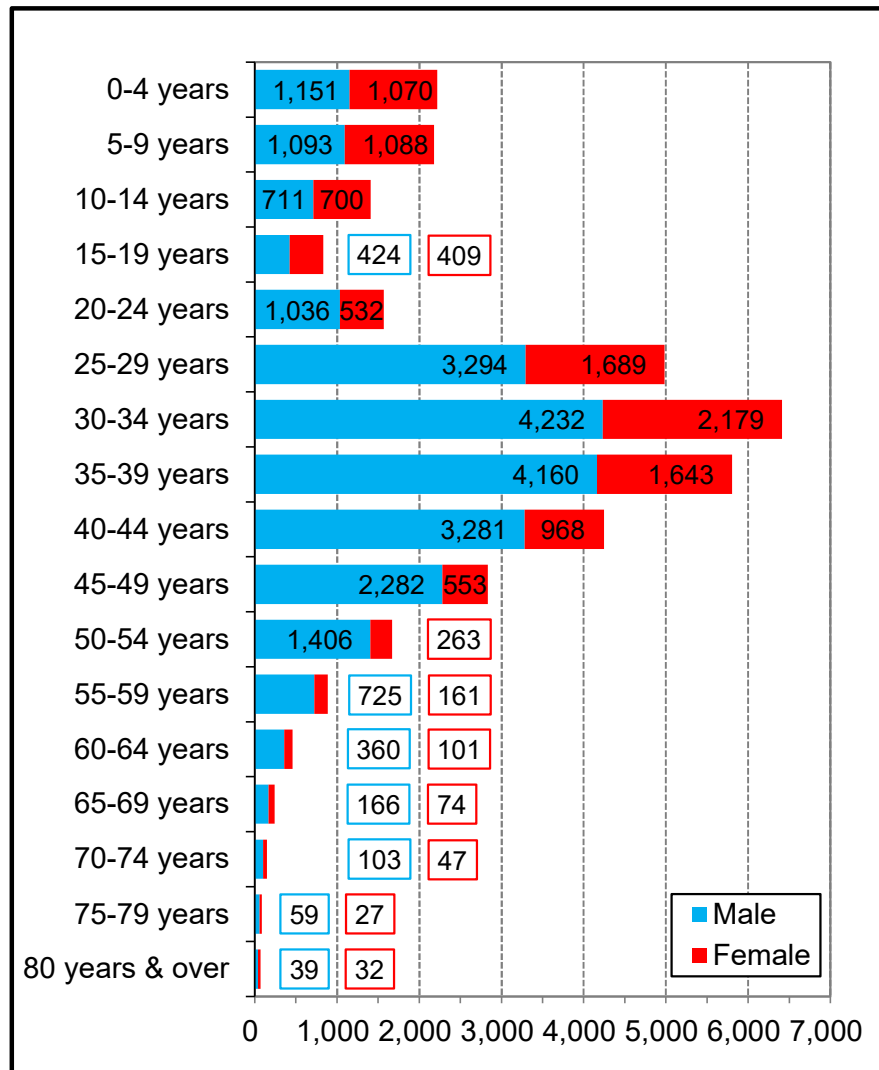
